### Mobile Phones.

To maintain the safety of children in school, the use of mobile phones to take photographs or to use in any other way is strictly prohibited in school. This applies to staff and parents.

Staff may use their mobile phones in the office or the staffroom as long as no children are present. They are also permitted to use their phones after 4.30pm as long as no children are on site. This is also the same for contractors. On a few occasions, contractors may use their phones to take photographs of outside equipment but again this is with permission and as long as no children are present.

We will be shortly training the children on what to do if they see an adult using their phone in school. This will simply be to make sure they tell a responsible adult.

There will be many occasions when photographs will be allowed, such as Christmas Sharing Assemblies etc. These photographs would be for personal use only and not to be uploaded to social media.

Please do not take offence if an adult approaches you to remind you

about school policy. The children's safety is our highest priority.
