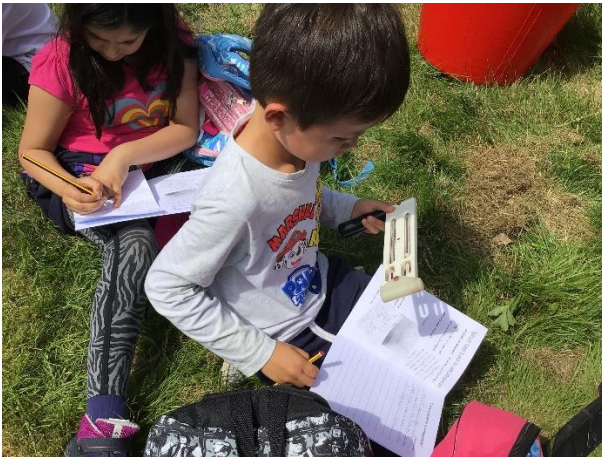
UPDATES AND INFORMATION

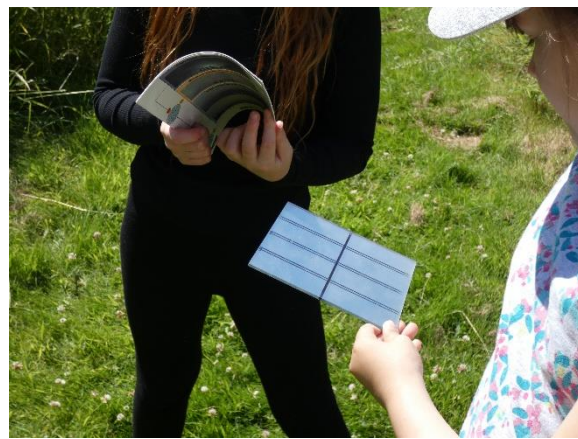
Year 2 Trip

On Wednesday this week Year 2 went to Preston Montford to undertake a Geography adventure with Barnaby Bear. They started the day by using a map of the site and their compass point knowledge to plan their route to their first activity.



They used a weather station to take readings of the amount of rainfall (luckily none), temperature, wind speed using an anemometer, ground temperature with a thermometer in the ground and using a mirror to calculate the fraction of the sky covered in clouds.





They used a variety of different equipment to hunt for insects in different types of microhabitats.





In the afternoon they went into the woods and worked as a team to build Barnaby shelters and then played leaf bingo trying to identify the trees in the area using their leaves and an identification guide. They then made bark rubbings of the different trees. Recording all their results in their own explorer journals. They all had a great time and learnt lots.
