Have a great weekend and make sure that you enjoy whatever you are doing.

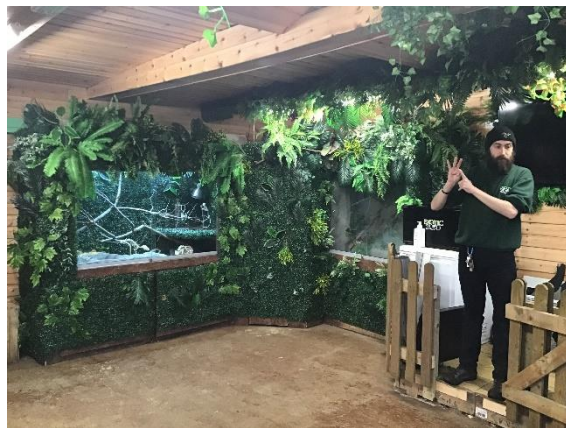

## Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> April Year 1 Exotic Zoo Educational Visit.

As part of our science work in year 1 we visited our local exotic zoo. We explored animal classifications and variations. It was so much fun and very exciting exploring the Rainforest Zone, Desert Zone, Nocturnal Area and our Farmyard. The Exotic Zoo was a great learning experience for us and we had the opportunity to explore the different zones and learn about exciting habitats around the world and the animals that call them their homes despite the pouring rain. The staff at the exotic zoo believe interacting with some of the friendly animals can be the inspiration young people need to respect the environment and give them a lifelong enthusiasm for wildlife.



## Year 2 – Science

In Year 2 this week we have been learning about classifying animals and sorting them into groups.
