Developing basic running, jumping and throwing techniques.

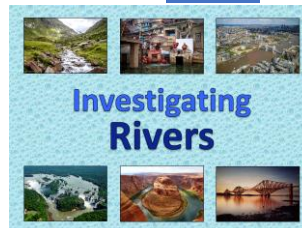
