English - Stone Age Boy

We will be sharing our foundational knowledge on the Stone in our English lessons and using this to write an instructional text on how to build a mammoth.

Maths - Multiplication & Division

Children will learn multiplication and division facts across the 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

Science - Rocks

Children will learn about the names and formation of different types of rock. They will test their properties and their uses.

Religious Education - What is the Trinity?

Children will learn that Christians believe in God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. Children will investigate how this is shown in Christian symbols and how they are connected.

Design & Technology - Levers and linkages

Children will design a product with a slider or lever and explain the user or purpose.

Modern Foreign Language (French) - Animals

We will learn the names of farm and zoo animals in French.

Music - Let Your Spirit Free

Children will learn new musical vocabulary such as pitch, tempo, sound tone etc

Computing - Branching and Databases

Children will learn how to create programming statements to design a program involving these statements.

PHSE - Safe Relationships

Children will learn to recognise the features of positive relationships and those that may be harmful.

History - Stone Age, Iron Age and Bronze Age -

Children will learn about how these pre-civilisations lived. This includes how they fed themselves, provided shelter and defended themselves.
