English

Science

Growing plants.
We will ensure that all children can describe how plants that have grown from seeds and bulbs develop over time. We will identify the best conditions for plants to grow and look at differences and similarities between seeds and bulbs.

Maths

Fractions.
We will be recognising and finding halves, quarters, thirds and a whole.
Time.
We will develop our ability to tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past and quarter to the hour. We will learn how many minutes in an hour and hours in a day.

Religious Education

Beginning to learn about Islam: Muslims and Mosques in Telford and Wrekin
We will learn that a Mosque is a sacred place for Muslims, features that a Mosque has and make links to our own special place.
